I attended A&E where we were visiting in Spain and was diagnosed with a fracture at the top of the humerus bone (shoulder). I returned home on Monday as planned... and advised to attended A&E at Russells Hall, the fracture was confirmed and I was referred to the fracture clinic. I had a virtual appointment (i.e. a phone call) with the clinic yesterday and been advised to wear the sling for 4-6 weeks; and referred for physio (not sure when that will start) I have been signed off from work for 4 weeks; which will need to be reviewed towards the end of the 4 weeks...my sister is staying with me at the moment as I can't dress myself at the moment and can't drive. The pain is not too bad, until I try and move the arm....thank you for your prayers, offers of help and good wishes.. Catherine
