#### SHARED WORSHIP THIS WEEK

We will continue our services online. The following services will still take place on Zoom and some will also be available on our parish web site or through audio files via email. For Zoom services and meetings an invitation will be sent to all 3 email News Groups. The Liturgy, if applicable, will be available on the website or shared on the screen.

### **Sunday**

- 9.30am 1030am St Andrew's Church building open for morning prayer
- 9:30am Holy Communion this will be 'live' on Zoom.
- **10:30am prayer/worship** praying through the Sunday liturgy individually but hopefully at the same time! This is available through the email News Groups and includes links to hymns and a printed sermon and is usually emailed out on the Saturday.

**11:30am Zoom coffee fellowship** – bring your own coffee to your computer and see and hear some of your church friends; for about 40 minutes.

# 2.30pm to 3.30pm All Saints Church Building open for led prayer and private prayer

**6:30pm Compline** on Zoom, about 20 minutes. A quiet and reflective service.

## **Tuesday**

**2:30pm Prayer meeting** on Zoom – about 30 minutes following the Prayer in Isolation leaflet.

**Thursday** – 8pm Fellowship Group on Zoom – everyone is welcome.

## Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

**9:15am Parish Prayer on Zoom** – an informal time of prayer similar to when we're meeting in our buildings, where we share the Gospel reading for the day and pray quietly for about 15 minutes.

All Saints Church will be open this Sunday the 2<sup>nd</sup>
August between 2.30pm and 3.30pm for private
prayer. The first 15 minutes will be simple lead
prayer.

Saint Andrew's Church will be open this Sunday the 2<sup>nd</sup> August between 9.30pm and 10.30pm for private prayer. The first 15 minutes will be simple lead prayer.

The Standing Committee and a 'Re-Entry' group with people from all 3 churches has now completed our risk assessment for all 3 churches in the team and we are working on our halls. Safety is our priority.

- ALL 3 CHURCHES HAVE BEEN SET UP FOR 2 METRE SOCIAL DISTANCING (ST PETER'S HAS NOT YET RE OPENED)
- HAND SANTISER WILL BE USED ON ENTERING AND LEAVING THE CHURCHES
- ANY SEATS USED WILL BE CLEANED (OR REMOVED)
  BEFORE THEY ARE USED AGAIN
- PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN BIBLE OR PRAYER BOOK AS NO BOOKS WILL BE AVAVILABLE IN CHURCH HOWEVER THERE WILL BE A LITURGY FOR THE LED PRAYER
- REVISED FACE COVERING ADVISE: PLEASE SEE BELOW THE NEW Advice FROM CHURCH OF ENGLAND.
- Face coverings are currently mandatory on public transport and will be mandatory in shops and in supermarkets from 24 July 2020. People are also encouraged to wear face coverings in enclosed public spaces where there are people they do not normally meet, such as a place of worship.
- We strongly advise that face coverings should be worn by all those attending a place of worship, including ministers, worshippers, staff, volunteers, contractors and visitors, where there may be other people present; remembering that they are mainly intended to protect other people, not the wearer, from coronavirus COVID-19 and that they are not a replacement for physical distancing and regular hand washing.

#### **FUNERAL SERVICES AT GORNAL WOOD**

A maximum of **16** mourners are allowed to be inside the chapel for a cremation service and a further **15** are allowed outside where there are relay speakers. For a burial service **30** mourners are allowed. Social distancing must still be observed. We continue to pray for all who are bereaved and grieving the loss of a loved one.

## MANY HAVE FOUND THIS HELPFUL! DAILY HOPE 0800 804 8044

Daily Hope, offers music, prayers and reflections as well as full worship services from the Church of England at the end of a telephone line. The line – which is available 24 hours a day on **0800 804 8044** – has been set up particularly with those unable to join online church services during the period of restrictions in mind.

Options available include materials also available digitally by the Church of England's Communications team such as <a href="Prayer">Prayer</a>
<a href="During the Day and Night Prayer">During the Day and Night Prayer</a>, updated daily, from Common Worship, and a recording of the Church of England <a href="weekly">weekly</a> national online service.

A section called Hymn Line offers callers a small selection of hymns, updated daily. An option entitled 'Hymns We Love', provides a hymn and reflection and is based on an initiative by the Connections group.
