#### SHARED WORSHIP THIS WEEK

**Lockdown will end on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December.** Although Dudley will be in tier 3, services in church can and will resume from Wednesday the 2<sup>nd</sup> December.

# Regarding Places of Worship and Tier 3 the Government say:

- places of worship remain open, but you must not attend with or socialise with anyone outside of your household or support bubble while you are there, unless a legal exemption applies
- weddings and funerals can go ahead with restrictions on the number of attendees – 15 people can attend wedding ceremonies, wedding receptions are not allowed, 30 people can attend funeral ceremonies, 15 people can attend linked commemorative events.

As always very strict hygiene will be followed to ensure we are Covid-19 safe.
